Overview: How to Obtain Add Health Phenotype Data and/or dbGaP Linkage File

- A limited set of Add Health phenotype data are available on dbGaP:
 - E.g., Age, sex, body mass index, and height
- Obtaining additional Add Health phenotype data **requires a contract**
 1. For users with an existing Add Health contract:
 - A dbGaP linkage file is required to match the dbGaP participant ID with the Add Health AID.
 - Obtaining the dbGaP linkage file requires a new data request (see slides 4-16)
 2. For users of Add Health public use data:
 - Use of Add Health genomic data requires an Add Health contract (see slides 18-29)
 3. For individuals without an existing Add Health contract:
 - See slides 18-29 for instructions



Overview: How to Access Add Health Phenotype Data With an Existing Contract





- To link the genomic data to the Add Health phenotype data you will need to request the dbGaP Linkage File through the CPC Data Portal: <https://data.cpc.unc.edu/>.
- Please note that your dbGaP and/or Add Health security plans may need to be revised to meet the security requirements for the combined phenotype - genotype files.
- There is a \$100 administrative fee for staff time to process this request.





dbGaP Linkage File: Required Files

- As shown on slide 12, access to the dbGaP linkage file requires the following four files
 - Add Health Linkage File Agreement
 - dbGaP – Add Health Data Use Certification Agreement
 - dbGaP – NIH-Approved dbGaP NIH Data Access Request
 - dbGaP – Add Health Linkage File Processing Fee (\$100)





Overview: How to Access Add Health Phenotype Data and dbGaP Linkage File Without an Existing Add Health Contract

- If you need additional phenotype data, you must apply for an Add Health restricted-use contract.
- Apply online through the CPC Data Portal: <https://data.cpc.unc.edu/>.
- When selecting the files for your contract, be sure to include the dbGaP Linkage File, which is needed to link genomic data to the phenotype data.
- Please note that your dbGaP security plan may need to be revised to meet the security requirements for the combined phenotype - genotype data.
- There is a \$1,100 administrative fee for the Add Health phenotype data and the dbGaP linkage file.






 - On your initial visit to the site to create the application, you will:
 - Choose datasets you are interested in using (you can always request more data later)
 - Submit your application.
- On the project list Select “[Add Health](#)”
- Select tab 
- Core Files are included with all contracts; click Core Files "Add Bundle" or let the “cart” do that for you at checkout.
- Hover over pink boxes to read about the requirements.
 - Note that you are not submitting required forms at this point.
- Click on dbGaP Linkage File and all other required phenotype files
- Select the blue button 
- Click the blue button 
- Fill out the “Applicant Contact Information” page
- Review the requirements and click the blue button 
- Shortly after you submit your application, you will receive an email from CPC Data Portal with instructions on how to continue.






