Wave III Grouping Variable

w3group.xpt

The Wave III grouping variable is different from the grouping variables for Waves I and II. Instead of creating separate variables for each geographic unit, there is one grouping variable that is 12 characters in length. The first 2 characters describe the unique state group, the first 5 characters identify the county, the first 11 characters are the tract, and the entire variable is the unique block group.
